Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! I know that we are living in a very different world now, and that life has become more precious to us with the rise and varying undates of COVID. It should most definitely be

precious to us with the rise and varying updates of COVID. It should most definitely be taken seriously and we as Christians should be cautious towards it. But we should not be afraid of it.

Paul tells us in Corinthians, "I tell you this, brothers: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written:

"Death is swallowed up in victory." "O death, where is your victory?

O death, where is your sting?"

The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."" (1 Cor. 15:50-58)

Sometimes, as sinful human beings, we forget how perishable and mortal our bodies truly are. Perhaps we may even take for granted that it was Christ Jesus who was also perishable and mortal as the Son of Man. Yet, he conquered death so that we could have the victory over it and receive the resurrection.

Don't worry. Ours is not the only generation to struggle with this. Even in Corinth, the Christians there worried about death and sickness, and were concerned about what will happen when they are called out of this life to their heavenly home.

We are not meant for this world and have no reason to fear it. The one who has been there since the beginning of creation, Jesus Christ, is still in charge of it. His Cross is our assurance and guarantee that we will be welcomed into heaven as it is ushered in on the day of the resurrection. On that day, this world will be destroyed along with the diseases that disturb our peace.

Until that day however, we love one another as Christ loves his church. We do the best we can to take care of the bodies that the Lord has given us as his holy temple. We show concern and kindness towards our neighbor. And when we come together, we fix our eyes on the Cross. It is there that Christ died and achieved that which we could not achieve, imperishability and immortality.

May you have a joyous end to your Epiphany Season. Soon we will approach Lent and remind ourselves on Ash Wednesday that we are dust and to dust we shall return. But take heart. Easter will also soon be upon us. Your servant in Christ,
