Pastor's Perspective

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked,

nor stands in the way of sinners,
nor sits in the seat of scoffers;
but his delight is in the law of the LORD,
and on his law he meditates day and night.
He is like a tree
planted by streams of water
that yields its fruit in its season,
and its leaf does not wither.
In all that he does, he prospers.
The wicked are not so,
but are like chaff that the wind drives away.
Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,
nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;
for the LORD knows the way of the righteous,

(Psalm 1)

but the way of the wicked will perish.

The very first Psalm in the book of Psalms reminds us of those who are righteous and those who are wicked. The righteous act a certain way, or desire to act a certain way. The wicked choose to continually dwell in sin and act in disobedience to God's Word.

We know that God's Law is good and holy, but we break it. This is why someone perfect had to fulfill God's Law, and that could only be the one begotten of the Father before all worlds, Jesus Christ. He never broke it. He calls out those who are wicked and upholds those who seek true righteousness, which is only found in him.

When we repent of our sins on Sunday morning through Confession and Absolution, we are acknowledging that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed. We cannot free ourselves from our sinful condition. But in Christ, we are forgiven. He has freed us from sin and wickedness. In this repentance, we understand how beautiful God's Law is and that with a contrite heart we acknowledge how we have broken it, but sincerely desire to do good by the power of the Holy Spirit. We pray that the Holy Spirit never departs from us but renews a right spirit within us. You are blessed because of your Baptism into Christ. You are forgiven, and because of Christ can freely do works of the Law through the one who died on the Cross for our salvation. You shall not perish but have eternal life.

What is a man or woman of value?

In Psalm 51 I believe value is stated this way: "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." Understanding the need for a pure heart - a heart that is true to do the will of God is essential for value adding. The psalmist continues with the needed connection with the triune God: "Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me." Without God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit we cannot add value to sharing Jesus. Then, knowing we will fail, the psalmist asks that God "Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit,

to sustain me." He needs forgiveness so he can carry on with doing God's will. That value to an individual brings us to BCA- Lutheran School and its mission of "making disciples."

The psalmist completes the thought with "Then I will teach transgressors your ways, so that sinners will turn back to you." This is what we do when the school mission of First Lutheran supports BCA-Lutheran School through prayer and actions. We want our students to know Jesus, know they sin, know they are forgiven, and know that his or her salvation is secure in Christ's promises that he demonstrated on the cross, for them, for us.
